

Supporting your care-experienced students



Your students who are in care or have experience of being in care are our top priority.

We strongly encourage you to follow this checklist to ensure your care-experienced students are informed, supported, and empowered:

- Ensure that you are aware of the support and services that Become offer to care-experienced young people, for example, our Care Advice Line.
- Be sure to brief all care-experienced young people about what is going to take place in the school that day, in plenty of time.
- If any care-experienced young person does not want to take part in the day, ensure that support is put in place for them.
- Brief the social workers, foster parents and residential workers about what is happening at the school so that the young person can have support from all sides.
- Ensure care-experienced pupils at the school are aware of the local Children in Care Council, their local advocacy service, and the designated teacher within the school.
